**Updating 2012, 2013, and/or 2014 Normal Grazing Periods for
Livestock Forage Disaster Program (LFP)**

1 Overview

A Background

The 2014 Farm Bill made LFP a permanent program. The 2014 Farm Bill LFP provides payments to eligible livestock producers that have suffered livestock grazing losses because of a qualifying drought during the normal grazing period for the county, or grazing losses on rangeland managed by a Federal agency if the eligible livestock producer is prohibited by the Federal agency from grazing the normal permitted livestock on the managed rangeland because of a qualifying fire during the calendar year. The qualifying drought or fire must have occurred on or after October 1, 2011.

Notice LDAP-10 (obsolete), issued on August 26, 2009, provided State Offices with instructions for establishing normal LFP grazing periods for each eligible type of pastureland or grazing land for 2008 Farm Bill LFP.

Notice LDAP-4 (obsolete), issued on June 29, 2009, provided State Offices with instructions for submitting names of the users who will be granted State Office administrative rights to update normal LFP grazing periods in the system.

1-LDAP, Part 7, Section 2 provides instructions for using the State Office administrative process to add, edit, and/or delete normal LFP grazing periods in the automated system.

B Purpose

This notice:

- provides guidance to STC’s for reviewing and updating 2012, 2013, and 2014 normal LFP grazing periods for each eligible type of pastureland or grazing land
- provides the deadline for updating 2012, 2013, and 2014 normal LFP grazing periods for each eligible type of pastureland or grazing land
- provides instructions for updating names of State Office employees needing access to the State Office administrative process to add or modify normal LFP grazing periods.

2 Reviewing and Updating 2012, 2013, and 2014 Normal LFP Grazing Periods

A Overview

The normal LFP grazing periods established for 2011 LFP were rolled over to 2012, 2013, and 2014 in the automated system. STC's shall review the 2011 normal LFP grazing periods to determine whether any updates need to be made in any of the years 2012, 2013, and/or 2014.

Important: The normal grazing period updated for each pasture or grazing crop type shall be consistent with those established for the applicable year for NAP purposes. If the sales closing date has passed for the specific pasture or grazing crop type for the applicable year, the normal grazing period for that specific pasture or grazing crop may not be changed except for the next crop year.

B Updating Grazing Periods

If STC determines that any grazing periods shall be changed in either 2012, 2013, or 2014, the State Office administrative user shall access the LFP application system according 1-LDAP, Part 7, Section 2 to modify the normal LFP grazing periods.

C Deadline

All modifications to normal LFP grazing periods shall be made in the automated system no later than March 31, 2014.
